APHA Show Rules:

1. APHA Age Groups:

Youth & Amateur– Exhibitor's age as of Jan 1, 2010

Youth & Amateur Exhibitors must provide age on entry form

2. Each APHA exhibitor MUST show a current APHA membership card to the show secretary. A replacement membership card may be purchased at the show.

3. APHA Novice Amateurs MUST show 2010 Amateur Card to show secretary at each show and cannot show horses that they do not own in accordance with APHA Rule AM-020.A. **You must have copy of transferred papers in hand to show. Temporary card may be purchased at the show.**

4. APHA Novice Youth MUST show 2010 card to show secretary at each show. (YP-210). Temporary card may be purchased at the show.

5. APHA Classes will follow APHA Rules

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General Show Rules:

- 1 Management reserves the right to reclassify exhibitors.
- 2 High Points will be figured on the Six-Point System.
- 3 Open Show Exhibitors may only show in one age division - (Green Novice, Novice, Junior, *Senior or Adult*)
- 5 Exhibitors may ride more than one (1) horse, but points will be kept on each horse and rider combination.
- 6 "All Day" fees apply to **EACH** horse/rider/family combination.
- 7 No Entries taken after the class begins.
- 8 Protests must be in writing, accompanied by \$25.00 cash, filed with the show secretary during or at the conclusion of the show. Judges decisions are final and cannot be protested.
- 9 Minor exhibitors **ARE NOT** allowed to show without signature of parent or legal guardian.
- 10 No refunds or substitutions.
- 12 Management has the right to excuse any horse or person showing unsafe or objectionable behavior in the arena or on the grounds.
- 13 Timed events will be run & the gate closed. Exhibitors must not begin their run before the gate is closed.
- 14 Timed event exhibitors must make an unassisted entry into the arena.
- 15 Training tack is not allowed in judged events.
- 16 Safety helmets are strongly recommended.
- 17 Riding two-handed in western judged events in Green Novice and Novice classes is permitted without regard to type of bit. Juniors, Seniors and Adults must ride one handed in western judged events when using a curb bit or may ride two-handed when using a bosal or snaffle.
- 18 Proof of negative Coggins within the last year required on each horse.
- 19 Show management reserves the right to interpret rules. All decisions are final. 4-H rules shall be used for referral for 4H classes. APHA rules for APHA Classes
- 20 Classes with less than three (3) exhibitors may be cancelled.

Show Hi Point Awards:

Category Hi Point Awards will be given for the following Categories

English: Senior Youth, Junior Youth, Adult, Nov Youth, Green Nov Youth, APHA Novice Youth, APHA Novice Amateur
Western: Senior Youth, Junior Youth, Adult, Nov Youth, Green Nov Youth, APHA Novice Youth, APHA Novice Amateur
Speed: Senior Youth, Junior Youth, Adult, Nov Youth, Green Nov Youth, APHA Novice Youth, APHA Novice Amateur

To qualify for these awards, horse/rider combination must be shown in 3 performance events

Western Classes include: Showmanship, Western Pleasure, Western Horsemanship, Reining and Trail
English Classes include: Hunter Under Saddle, Hunt Seat Equitation
Speed Classes include: Barrels, Poles, and Stakes

Overall Hi Point and Reserve Hi Point Awards

Hi Point and Reserve Hi Point awards will be given to the horse rider combination earning the most points for the following: Senior Youth, Junior Youth, Adult, Nov Youth, Green Nov Youth, APHA Novice Youth, and APHA Novice Amateur. To qualify for these awards, the horse/rider combination must be shown in at least 3 performance events.

Warning: Under Texas Law (Chapter 87, Civil Practice and Remedies Code) An Equine professional is not liable for an injury to or the death of a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities.

Arena Rules: Absolutely NO Outside alcohol permitted inside ANY part of Diamond W Buildings including arena, expo and stall area.

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4H AGE DIVISION REQUIREMENTS (AGE AS OF AUGUST 31, 2009):

Leadline Youth– Age 8 and under. May not enter any other class. Requires an adult to lead

Green Novice Youth – Limited to children who have never loped, cantered, or galloped in any competition and have not exhibited in any mounted point earning class prior to August 31, 2009. These classes will be walk/jog/trot only. Any gait other than walk/jog/trot in the class will be cause for disqualification in that class.

Novice Youth – Limited to children who have not won more than 2 first places in any one particular class consisting of 3 or more riders prior to the show. In the case of a “show series”, a rider will remain a Novice till the series ends regardless of how many first places won.

Junior Youth – 13 years of age and under

Senior Youth - ages 14-18

Adult – 19 years of age and over

ATTIRE:

Formal show attire not required. Exhibitors in Showmanship, Western, and Speed are required to wear a long sleeved shirt, western hat, typical cowboy boots, or lace-up ropers. All other footwear is prohibited. English classes require hunt seat attire with hunt cap and English boots. Judge may require jackets. Safety helmets are strongly recommended
