- Entry Fees:** \$16.00/class or Max \$80.00/horse Youth Lead Line—Free
- Crossover:** Once a horse has maxed out in a division (paid the \$80 all day fee), that horse may crossover to **ALL** eligible divisions with no additional entry fee (TSCC fee only)
Practice Trail - Each Trail horse will be charged \$10 mandatory
Practice Over Fence – Each over fence horse will be charged \$10 mandatory
- Nov Youth “Ride Up For Free”** Enter a Novice Youth class and “ride up” in the respective youth class for FREE (TSCC fee only)
- FUTURITY:** **Must be entered by 7:00 p.m. then night before the class.**
\$125/class if paid by 9/1/11; \$175/class if after 9/1/11 At least \$1000 added in each class
- Reining:** \$All Amateur & Open will be Jackpotted (included in entry fee)
\$31 per class (\$10 jackpot + \$5 to PPHSS finals)
- Cattle Classes:** \$All Amateur & Open will be Jackpotted (included in entry fee)
Roping & Working Cowhorse \$31 per class (Jackpot \$10 + PPHSS \$5) + cattle charge
Cutting \$41 per class (Jackpot \$20 + PPHSS \$5) + cattle charge
- Cattle Fees:** Roping: \$20/run Cutting: \$60/run Working Cowhorse: \$30/run
CATTLE MUST BE RESERVED 10 DAYS PRIOR TO THE SHOW OR THERE WILL BE NO CATTLE CLASSES. THERE MUST BE 3 HORSES TO MAKE A CLASS

Show Rules:

- Age Groups: Performance Horses – Jr. Ages 5 & Under Performance Horses – Sr. Ages 6 & Over
Youth & Amateur– Exhibitor’s age as of Jan 1, 2011 & Date of Birth must be written on entry form
- Each exhibitor **MUST** show a current APHA membership card to the show secretary. A replacement membership card may be purchased at the show.
- Novice Amateurs and Amateurs **MUST** show 2011 Amateur Card to show secretary at each show and cannot show horses that they do not own in accordance with APHA Rule AM-020.A. **Must have copy of transferred papers in hand to show.** Temporary card may be purchased at the show.
- Novice Youth **MUST** show 2011 card to show secretary at each show. (YP-210). Temporary card may be purchased at the show.
- To qualify for Hi-Point must show in: Open - respective halter class and 3 performance categories; all others – respective halter class and 3 performance events
